**Want to help improve the teen mental health in the community?**

The Mental Health Ambassadors (MHA) and Pioneers (MHP) is seeking 6 youth, ages 14-18, to join our team. MHA & MHP will focus on addressing the mental health crisis of Black and Brown teenagers through education, resource-sharing, innovative self-care workshops, and city-wide coalition-building. This is a great position for youth interested in public health, human services, counseling, or behavioral health. MHA is our first-year program. MHP is for second and third-year teen employees.

**What you would be doing...**

- Learn about mental health and its impact on BIPOC communities; become certified in the Mental Health First Aid course with licensed clinicians, and explore self-care strategies.
- Create and host innovative self-care workshops for your peers, schools, and youth groups
- Develop and share mental health resources with teens, parents, and the community, including conducting a survey and sharing resources at community events.
- Collaborate with other youth organizations and elected officials to educate and advocate for more school and community-based teen mental health resources.
- Develop a teen-led and teen-focused workshops for middle and high school students on understanding mental wellness and healthy coping strategies.

**The ideal candidate will have the following skills:**

- Interest in mental health education and mental wellness in our community
- Willingness to work as a peer educator and role model
- Willingness to grow in public speaking and workshop presentations
- Ability to work on and contribute to team success and goals
