**Want to help improve teen mental health in our community?**

Boston Project Ministries is hiring **12 teens (ages 14–18)** to join our **Mental Health Ambassadors (MHA)** and **Mental Health Pioneers (MHP)** team—a paid youth job where you'll take **peer-led action** to support Black and Brown teens through education, workshops, resource-sharing, and city-wide partnership. This role is a great fit if you're interested in **public health, human services, counseling, or behavioral health**. **MHA** is for first-year participants; **MHP** is for returning teen employees ready to grow as leaders. **Experience is helpful, but passion matters most.**

**What you would be doing...**

- Learn about teen mental health—especially its impact on BIPOC communities—and become **certified in Youth Mental Health First Aid** with licensed clinicians.
- Design and lead **teen-friendly self-care and coping workshops** for youth programs and peers.
- Create and share practical mental wellness resources for teens and families (including helping run a survey and hosting resource tables at community events).
- Develop and care for mental health green spaces in the community.
- Collaborate with other youth organizations and local leaders to **advocate for stronger school- and community-based mental health supports.**

**The ideal candidate will have the following qualities:**

- **Compassionate and trustworthy** — can hold sensitive topics with respect.
- **Strong communicator** — listens well and can lead workshops or speak to groups.
- **Reliable and committed** — shows up consistently for trainings, events, and responsibilities.
- **Team-oriented collaborator** — works well with other teens, staff, and community partners.
- **Curious and growth-minded** — eager to learn and build new skills

This is a seasonal, non-exempt position with a pay rate of \$15.00-\$16.50 per hour, averaging 25 hours per week for 7 weeks—potential summer earnings of \$2,625.00 before taxes and withholdings.
